

Glenlee Update

Glenyss Barnham, from the Friends of Glenlee Inc , has provided an update on what has been happening with the development.

We are entering the final lap in the fight to Save Glenlee and we fight a formidable opponent. The first sitting of the Land and Environment Court has been set down for Friday, 22 October 2021. To have the best chance of presenting a successful case, we need to engage one or two experts to provide a report on the full impact of the development, to place before the court. A report by a Town Planner and Ecologist will carry considerable weight.

We need your help to raise a fighting fund of \$25,000 to engage these experts and pay legal fees, a considerable amount of money, but it may mean the difference between saving Glenlee and seeing it destroyed.

The Nature Conservation Council has very generously offered to make their donation facilities available to us, giving your donation tax-deductibility. The receipt will be issued in their name but 100% of the donations will come to our Save Glenlee fund.
