



Come to a rally to help save Glenlee

The Friends of Glenlee Incorporated invites you to a public rally to be held:

Date: Saturday 23 April 2022 Time: 10.00 am

Location: Heinrich Reserve – 40D Bayside Drive, Lugarno

Residents of Lugarno, Peakhurst, Oatley and surrounding suburbs have been campaigning to save Glenlee, a 2.5 hectare historic property on the Georges River. Development of this site at 80 Boronia Parade would lead to destruction of a foreshore corridor extending from Oatley to the Georges River National Park. Protecting its endangered native wildlife and natural vegetation is important, as well as Glenlee's historical and cultural heritage.

The site currently has an Interim Heritage Order, and its preservation has been supported by Liberal, Labor and Greens politicians, as well as Georges River councillors. The site is up for sale through Colliers – for as little as \$10m. But no funding has been put up by government or Council to buy it yet.
